AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES), ARTICLE 3 (LICENSES), DIVISION 2 (OPERATIONS AND PREMISES REGULATIONS), SECTION 4-97 (HOURS OF OPERATION OF LICENSED PREMISES) OF THE VILLAGE CODE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, Kankakee County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Village Code Amended</u>. Chapter 4 ("Alcoholic Beverages"), Article 3 ("Licenses"), Division 2 ("Operations and Premises Regulations"), Section 4-97 ("Hours of Operation of Licensed Premises") of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Bradley is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4-97. - Hours of operation of licensed premises.

No person shall sell, permit to be sold, offer for sale at retail, or give away any liquor between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive; nor between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and $10\pm:00$ a.m. on Sundays. Licensees shall close the establishment described in their respective licenses to entrance by the public, at all hours when the retail sale of alcoholic liquors is not authorized. No licensee shall permit patrons to remain in the licensed premises more than 30 minutes after the closing time set forth in this section. The respective time and times above enumerated and set forth are in the time standard prevailing at the date of the sale at retail of alcoholic liquor and on the dates of the changes to and from daylight saving time the early morning closing hours shall be by central standard time.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances</u>. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.
