ORDINANCE NO. 0-9-21-6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON FRANKLIN STREET, IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, ILLINOIS, COUNTY OF KANKAKEE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village is authorized to regulate the use of streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-302 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, the Village is authorized to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances to such intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley finds that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to regulate the intersection of Franklin Street and Dearborn Avenue and Euclid Avenue in the Village of Bradley by placing stop signs where Franklin Street crosses Dearborn Avenue and Euclid Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct and complete, and further declare that the same are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the superintendent of streets and alleys to erect stops signs on Franklin Street, in the Village of Bradley, at its intersection with Dearborn Avenue and Euclid Avenue, where indicated and depicted as red signs in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That all ordinances, Ordinances, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Chief Barber.

Earlier in the week I was speaking with Bradley Dist 61 Superintendent Goselin who mentioned a perceived speeding problem on Franklin St. Specifically, he stated that when the kids were at the Franklin Park, which doubles for a Bus Stop in the mornings, traffic moves fast by the kids. I was in the area on Thursday, Sept 15th from 0730-0745 and observed several vehicles begin to accelerate only to brake upon seeing the squad car. I believe his concern for speeding traffic and the safety of the children at the Bus stop & Park. Upon surveying Franklin St there are no STOP Signs posted on Franklin St between Schuyler and Clinton Ave. Considering the placement and use of the park I recommend we Post New STOP Signs for East/West traffic on Franklin St on either side of Franklin Park. The enclosed image shows the satellite map of Franklin St and Franklin Park (Yellow Triangle) and the currently posted signs in the area of the park. My suggestion are the




