ORDINANCE NO. Q - S - Q - Q

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ALONG IL ROUTE 50 AND ARMOUR ROAD WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village has the authority to regulate the use of streets and roadways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, the Village has the authority to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles over and upon streets and roadways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley ("Village") has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Illinois, by and through the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT"), for the purpose of improvements made to the intersection of Armour Road and State Route 50 within the corporate boundaries of the Village and other related work (collectively the "Road Project"); and

WHEREAS, as part of said Agreement, the Village agreed to restrict parking along State Route 50 and Armour Road within the corporate boundaries of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees have determined that restricting parking along State Route 50 and Armour Road within the corporate boundaries of the Village is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Bradley.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, parking is hereby prohibited on both sides of State Route 50 and Armour Road anywhere within the corporate boundaries of the Village of Bradley; and

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation that violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in accordance with the Village's code of ordinances.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
