AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PENALTY PROVISIONS OF THE VILLAGE CODE IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper, so long as the maximum fine or penalty, except civil penalties provided for failure to make returns or to pay any taxes levied, does not exceed \$750 and six (6) months of imprisonment; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously adopted 65 ILCS 5/1-2.2-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code providing for the administrative adjudication of certain violations of the Village's municipal code, penalties for said violations being limited as provided in 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208.3 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, the Village previously adopted a system of administrative adjudication for standing and parking violations and vehicle compliance violations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208.3, the Village's ordinance providing for such administrative adjudication must provide a schedule of civil fines and penalties for late payments; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley wishes to update certain penalty provisions in the Village Code to clarify the fines and penalties to be imposed within administrative adjudications, including general penalty provisions and penalty provisions for violations of stopping, standing, parking, and compliance provisions of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLE: The preamble to this Ordinance is incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this Section 1.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT: That section 1-6 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1-6. – "General penalty for violation of Code; continuing violations," paragraphs (1) and (2) shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

Sec. 1-6. - General penalty for violation of Code; continuing violations.

Unless otherwise specified in this Code or limited by state statute:

(1) Whenever in this Code or in any village ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or a violation or an offense, or whenever in this Code or village ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, where no specific penalty is provided, the violation of any of the provisions of this Code or any village ordinance shall be punished by fines in the amounts below with respect to the Code provision violated:

First offense:	\$50.00
Second Offense:	\$100.00
Third Offense:	\$250.00
Subsequent Offenses:	\$500.00 to \$750.00

(2) Whenever in this Code or in any village ordinance any act or omission is declared to be a misdemeanor, the violation of that provision of this Code or any ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by incarceration for a period not exceeding six months and a fine for the Code provision or ordinance violated to be imposed as follows:

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT: That section 18-2 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT: That section 52-2 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 52-2. - "Adoption of state vehicle code provisions by reference" paragraph (e) shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

(e) All provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code as adopted in this chapter shall be subject to the penalties provided by the applicable Illinois Vehicle Code section or as delineated in 730 ILCS 5/5-4.5-5 et seq., of the Unified Code of Corrections, except that violations of the provisions of Chapter 52. – "Traffic and Vehicles" Article IV. – "Stopping, Standing, Parking and Compliance" shall be subject to those penalties provided in Sec. 18-2. – "Penalty; fines" of this Code.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT: That section 52-98 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 52-98. – "Penalties for violations" shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT: That section 18-2 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-2. – "Penalty; fines," Chapter 52 – "Traffic and Vehicles" shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

SECTION 8. REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES: All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
