**ORDINANCE NO. O-8-21-2**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TURNING OF VEHICLES FROM OF A CERTAIN ALLEYWAY ADJOINING ILLINOIS ROUTE 50/S. KINZIE AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2) authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village to regulate the use of the streets and other municipal property under the Village's jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) further authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village, through the exercise of the Village's police powers, to regulate or prohibit the turning of vehicles at intersections of streets and highways under the Village's jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has jurisdiction over that public alleyway (the "Alley") that is located immediately south of the 900 block of East Broadway Street on the southeast corner of the intersection of East Broadway Street and Illinois Route 50/S. Kinzie Avenue ("Rt. 50") (for the avoidance of doubt, the Alley is depicted on Exhibit A attached hereto and fully incorporated herein); and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to regulate and limit the turning of vehicles from the Alley onto Rt. 50 as set forth in this Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.** It is and shall hereinafter be unlawful for any person to turn left from the Alley onto southbound Rt. 50.

**SECTION 3.** The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to erect or cause the erection of such signs as are necessary to give reasonable notice of the turning restrictions imposed by this Ordinance upon the Alley.

**SECTION 4.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent

jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

**SECTION 5.** That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 6.** That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 7.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


