ORDINANCE NO. O-5-16-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 0-7-09-4 AND REINSTATING THE POSITION OF DEPUTY CHIEF IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NO. 0-6-03-2

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2009, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley passed Ordinance No. O-7-09-4, "An Ordinance Eliminating the Position of Deputy Chief in the Village of Bradley Police Department"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-7-09-4 effectively repealed, rescinded and revoked Ordinance No. O-6-03-2, "An Ordinance for Appointment of a Deputy Chief", which in fact created the position of Deputy Chief within the Village of Bradley in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-4; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley now desire to repeal Ordinance No. O-7-09-4 and to reinstate the position of Deputy Chief in the Village of Bradley Police Department, in accordance with O-6-03-2 and 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-4;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, State of Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Repeal, Rescission and Revocation of Ordinance No. O-7-09-4.</u> Village of Bradley Ordinance No. O-7-09-4, "An Ordinance Eliminating The Position of Deputy Chief in the Village of Bradley Police Department", is hereby repealed, rescinded and revoked in its entirety. As a result, Ordinance No. O-6-03-2, "An Ordinance for Appointment of a Deputy Chief", is reinstated and effective.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances</u>. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.

ORDINANCE NO. O-7-09-4

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE POSITION OF DEPUTY CHIEF IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, Kankakee County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Code of Ordinances Amended</u>. Chapter 15 ("Police"), Article II ("Police Chief"), Section 15-48 is amended by deleting Section 15-48 in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 15-48. Deputy chief.

There shall be in the Village of Bradley Police Department the position of deputy chief who shall be appointed by the chief of the police department. The deputy chief-position shall be an exempt rank immediately below that of chief. The deputy chief may be appointed from any rank of sworn, full time officers of the Village of Bradley Police Department, but must have at least five (5) years of full time service as a police officer-in the department. The deputy chief shall serve at the discretion of the chief and, if removed from the position, shall revert to the rank held immediately prior to appointment to the deputy chief position.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Repeal, Rescission and Revocation of Ordinance Number O-6-03-2.</u> Village of Bradley Ordinance Number O-6-03-2, entitled "An Ordinance for Appointment of a Deputy Chief," is hereby repealed, rescinded and revoked in its entirety.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.</u> If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.

ORDINANCE NO. O-6-03-2

AN ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY CHIEF

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY that:

SECTION I: There shall be in the Village of Bradley Police Department the position of Deputy Chief who shall be appointed by the Chief of the Police Department. The Deputy Chief position shall be an exempt rank immediately below that of Chief. The Deputy Chief may be appointed from any rank of sworn, full time officers of the Village of Bradley Police Department, but must have at least five (5) years of full time service as a police officer in the department. The Deputy Chief shall serve at the discretion of the Chief and, if removed from the position, shall revert to the rank held immediately prior to appointment to the Deputy Chief position. Statutory law reference-65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-4.

SECTION II: It is the intention of the board of trustees and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Bradley, Illinois, and the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.
