AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON PART OF COOK BOULEVARD, LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO "RESIDENTS PARKING ONLY" AT CERTAIN TIMES

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village, through the exercise of the Village's police powers, to regulate the standing and parking of vehicles with respect to streets and highways under the Village's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-80-2a of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2a) authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village to restrict parking on streets located in areas zoned for residential use to "residents parking only"; and

WHEREAS, Cook Boulevard is a public highway located within the corporate boundaries of the Village and subject to the Village's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to restrict parking on part of Cook Boulevard to "residents parking only," as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Parking is and shall be restricted to "residents parking only" on that part of Cook Boulevard as lies between the intersection of said Cook Boulevard with W. Brookmont Boulevard and the intersection of said Cook Boulevard with S. Blaine Avenue, Monday through Friday, inclusive, between the hours of eight o'clock ante-meridian (8:00 a.m.) and ten o'clock post-meridian (10:00 p.m.).

SECTION 3. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to erect or cause the erection of such signs as are necessary to give reasonable notice of the parking restrictions imposed by this Ordinance upon the affected part of Cook Boulevard.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent

jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
