ORDINANCE NO. O-11-17-1

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS NO LONGER NECESSARY OR USEFUL FOR THE VILLAGE'S PUBLIC PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley owns certain personal property (the "Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Trustees currently serving on the Village Board hold the opinion that the Subject Property is no longer necessary or useful for the Village's public purposes; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Trustees currently serving on the Village Board agree that the Village's continued ownership of the Subject Property is not in the best interests of the Village or its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4) allows the Village to sell unnecessary personal property, such as the Subject Property under the current circumstances, in any manner that the Board may designate, with or without advertising the sale; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustee have determined that authorizing Chief Michael T. Johnston of the Bradley Police Department to sell the Subject Property by private sale is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That Chief Michael T. Johnston of the Bradley Police Department is hereby authorized to sell and offer for sale the following Village-owned personal property (the "Subject Property"):

- The 2011 Chevrolet Tahoe bearing the VIN: 1GNLC2E03BR359101
- The 2007 Chevrolet Impala bearing the VIN: 2G1WS55R279397275
- The 2010 Dodge Charger bearing the VIN: 2B3AA4CV7AH269210
- The 2010 Dodge Charger bearing the VIN: 2B3AA4CVXAH211673

SECTION 3. That the sale of the Subject Property shall be a private sale, with or without advertisement and with no requirement that such sale be completed after receiving competitive bids.

SECTION 4. That, in addition to selling and offering for sale the Subject Property, Chief Michael T. Johnston is further authorized, in his capacity as Chief of the Bradley Police Department, to take any and all actions and execute any and all documents necessary for the completion of any and all sale(s) of the Subject Property.

SECTION 5. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 7. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


