ORDINANCE NO. <u>0-9-21-7</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON WINANS AVENUE, IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, ILLINOIS, COUNTY OF KANKAKEE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village is authorized to regulate the use of streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-302 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, the Village is authorized to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances to such intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley finds that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to regulate the intersection of Winans Avenue, and Lemna Avenue in the Village of Bradley by placing stop signs where Winans Avenue crosses Lemna Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct and complete, and further declare that the same are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the superintendent of streets and alleys to erect stops signs on Winans Avenue in the Village of Bradley, at its intersection with Lemna Avenue, where indicated and depicted as red signs in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, Ordinances, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Chief Barber,

Earlier this week we discussed Traffic Complaints along Winans Ave. We requested Extra Patrols for Traffic Enforcement in the area and surveyed the area for physical markings. If was discovered that they are No STOP Signs posted on Winans Ave between Northfield Meadows Blvd and Armour Rd, even though it intersects with Lemma Ave which is the main through street in the neighborhood. It was also discovered that there is only 1 Speed Sign posted just south of Northfield Meadows Blvd for S/B traffic.

It is my suggestion that we can eleviate most Traffic Control Complaints by Posting Additional Speed Signs on either side of Lemna Ave and for N/B Winans Ave after Leon Way. I also suggest posting additional STOP Signs at the Lemna Ave intersection. All Proposals outlined in Yellow on Attached Map.
