WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that Eagle Fountain Works, Inc. was the lowest responsible bid for the respective Project; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to accept the bid from Eagle Fountain Works, Inc. in the total amount of nineteen-thousand, two-hundred, thirty-two and 00/100 (19,232.00) for the 2022 Pone Aeration Project (a copy of the Eagle Fountain bid is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find and declare that the bid received by Eagle Fountain Works, Inc. for the 2022 Pond Aeration Project, a copy which is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> and fully incorporated herein, is fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the Village and hereby awards said contract to Eagle Fountain Works, Inc.for the amount of nineteen thousand, two-hundred, thirty-two and 00/100 (19,232.00)

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby authorize and direct the Public Works Director to take any actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to accept the bid for the Project and to award the vendor the contract bid.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Our large forest green PVC molded float body, 200' SJEOOW wiring harness, 6 each machined brass LED low voltage surface mount light fixtures with high power LED projection bulbs, 230 volt stainless steel lighting power center with 230/12 volt transformer and photoelectric controls, Intermatic T30404R 8 circuit service panel with Non GFCI pump control breakers, automatic timers, photo controls and anchor ropes. This unit ships 99.9% assembled and weight is approx. 380 pounds each. Two sets of spray heads are included in a 3 tiered and fanjet pattern. Spray size is approx 40'H X 40'W. Lighting is controlled by photo controls and the entire fountain is timer controlled for automatic operation. This fountain is sized for ponds at least 5 to 6 feet deep and at least 2-3 acres minimum in surface area. Brief Summary:

In 2021, the Village began a program to improve our pond maintenance and aesthetics. A newer, environmentally friendly chemical is being used and fountains were being added. This FY, we are adding another pond to the project. Initial pumps were selected based on the size of the ponds. However, we realize now that larger pumps would have improved the circulation needed. It is our plan to order 2 new, larger, fountain systems for the existing Pheasant Run Pond and the Cardinal Dr Pond. And then locate the 2 smaller pumps in the Eastern pond located in Hunters Run (north end/south end). Electricity already exists at new pond and installation will be completed by in-house labor.
