## A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID IN CONNECTION WITH THE SITE UTILITY WORK AT THE BRADLEY SPORTS COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, on or around April 10, 2024, the Village published an advertisement for bids for the site utility work at the Bradley Sports Complex (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village opened and reviewed all bids received in relation to the Project on April 26, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that Tenco Excavating Inc., (Tenco) was the lowest responsible bidder of the respective project; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to accept the bid from Tenco Excavating Inc., (Tenco) in the total amount of six million seven hundred twelve thousand one hundred seventy one dollars and 00/100 (\$6,712,171.00) for the site utilities work at the Bradley Sports Complex (a copy of the bid tabulations is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein); and

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find and declare that the bid received by Tenco Excavating Inc. for the site utility work at the Bradley Sports Complex, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, is fair, reasonable and acceptable to the Village and hereby awards said contract to Tenco Excavating Inc. for the amount of six million seven hundred twelve thousand one hundred seventy one dollars and 00/100 (\$6,712,171.00).

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby authorize and direct the Village President to take any actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to accept the bid for the Project and to award the vendor the contract bid.

**SECTION 4.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent


