WHEREAS, the Union and Village have reached an Agreement outlined in the attached Letter Agreement that resolves the issue(s) associated with the referenced grievance, subject to Village Board approval;

WHEREAS, the Village has examined said Letter Agreement and deems it fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

SECTION 2. Memorandum of Understanding Approved. The Letter Agreement dated 5/27/20 attached as Exhibit A is approved and the Acting Village President, Mike Watson, is authorized to execute said Agreement.

### VOB and Labor Council's Letter Agreement 05/27/20

Subject to and conditioned upon Village Board approval, the Village of Bradley and the IL FOP Labor Council's ("Union") agree to the following terms and conditions for matters associated with former Village employees Jeanne Richard and Renetta Smith.

l) In recognition of their years of service, as opposed to any alleged accrued retirement insurance rights, the Village proposes to pay the two (2) former dispatchers listed below (who were hired prior to June 1, 2000 and had 20 or more years of active service at the time their employment at the Village ended) an amount equal to two thousand three hundred fifty dollars and No/100 (\$2,350.00) per year of service. This payment is reflected below.

- At the request of the Union as well as above referenced former employees (Richard and Smith) the payments will be directed into the existing Village of Bradley Retirement Healthcare Funding Plan (VOB RHFP), commonly referred to as VEBA. The Village agrees to cooperate in directing payment to a modified VEBA plan, which will be submitted by the FOP and subject to approval by the Village Board by way of a formal Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Direction of said payment in this manner is subject to and conditioned upon representations of the plan administrator, IPPFA, that said direction of such payments are permitted and that the plan allows for establishment of new members (Richard and Smith). See attached email from Joel J. Babbitt, CLU, IPPFA VEBA Claim Administrator. The Village, however, makes no representations concerning the ability to amend the VEBA plan as referenced in the attached email. Accordingly, it is agreed and understood that the Village holds no liability outside of the payment directed to VEBA and will not be liable or responsible for any additional sums of money outside of the referenced payment(s).
- 3) In order to be eligible for the payout provided for in this Agreement, former dispatchers Jeanne Richard and Renetta Smith must execute a complete settlement, release, and waiver of claims agreement to the Village's satisfaction.
- 4) This Agreement requires the proper amending of the said VEBA plan and failure of the plan participants to ratify the appropriate changes will nullify this Agreement.
- 5) Upon the execution of this Agreement by the respective parties, the Union withdraws the Grievance filed on or about April 3, 2020 relating to impasse bargaining. Further,

the Union agrees to waive any and all rights it may currently or subsequently possess to obtain any reparation, restitution, or redress for payment of former dispatchers employed by the Village of

- This Agreement shall not be deemed or construed to amend or alter any of the terms that exist in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement. Nor shall the aforesaid, MOU, be construed to extend new OPEB benefits to other Union members. The MOU shall be drafted with language to ensure clarity on this issue.
- It is agreed that nothing contained within this Agreement shall be precedent setting nor constitute past practices. This Agreement shall not be introduced, referred to, or in any other way utilized in any subsequent arbitration, litigation, or administration hearing except as may be necessary to enforce its provisions or terms.
