A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY FOR THE PURPOSES OF EDUCATIONAL ROBOT TESTING AND DRIVING.

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Verver (the "Applicant") is a science teacher and the coach of the Ironclad Robotics team ("Ironclad") at the Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested that the Village permit Ironclad to use unit #694 in the Northfield Square Mall (the "Subject Property") for the purposes of testing and driving robots built by Ironclad in anticipation of regional and notional robotics competitions (the "Proposed Use"); and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is presently zoned B-3 (Village Shopping Center); and

WHEREAS, Section 60-154(1)(az) permits "[s]chools, music and dance" in the B-3 district; and

WHEREAS, Section 60-154(1)(bq) permits "[o]ther uses which are of the same general character as the permitted uses in subsection (1)a through (1)bp of this section, as recommended by the planning and zoning commission and approved by the village board of trustees"; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, the Village of Bradley Planning and Zoning Commission (the "Plan Commission") considered the Applicant's request as relates to the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has determined that the Proposed Use is of the same general character as other uses permitted in the B-3 district, including but not limited to "schools, music and dance"; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has recommended that the Corporate Authorities of the Village approve the Proposed Use on the Subject Property and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby accept and adopt the Plan Commission's findings and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that approving the Proposed Use of the Subject Property, subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth herein, is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Applicant and Ironclad are hereby authorized and approved to use the Subject Property for the purposes of testing and driving robots built by Ironclad in anticipation of regional and notional robotics competitions, subject to the conditions and restrictions set forth in Section 3 of this Resolution, *infra*.

SECTION 3. The Applicant and/or Ironclad's use of the Subject Property, as approved by this Resolution, are subject to the following conditions and restrictions:

1. The approval of the Proposed Use shall be effective as of the date of this Resolution and shall continue until (100 15 2000) (the "Termination Date"). As of the Termination Date, this Resolution shall be automatically repealed without the need for any further action by the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
