# A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RECIPROCAL REPORTING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY

#### AND

### THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF MOMENCE COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO.1, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley ("Village") is an Illinois municipal corporation, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of Momence Community Unit School District No. 1, Kankakee County, Illinois ("District") is an Illinois Public School District; and

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes the need for educators and law enforcement officials to have access to information regarding activities of minor students in and out of school, so that they may work together in as efficient a manner as possible to prevent, eliminate and discourage acts of crime, violence and intimidation; and

WHEREAS, the Village and District desire to establish and maintain a reciprocal reporting system regarding criminal offenses committed by students, as authorized by law and as attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals Incorporated</u>. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth.
- Section2. Reciprocal Reporting Agreement Approved. The Reciprocal Reporting Agreement between the Village and the District is approved in substantially the form as attached in Exhibit A, subject to the review and approval of the Village Attorney and the review and approval of authorized officers of the District.
- Section 3. Execution of Agreement. The Village President is directed to execute the Reciprocal Reporting Agreement in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A, subject to the review and approval of the Village Attorney.
- Section 4. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances and Resolutions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity


thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution. All existing resolutions of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution.
