A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE OF STREETS AND HIGHWAYS BY THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY UNDER THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE

- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, as follows:
- Section 1. <u>Appropriation</u>. There is hereby appropriated the sum of four-hundred-thousand-dollars (\$400,000.00) of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the purpose of maintaining streets and highways under the applicable provisions of the Illinois Highway Code from November 1, 2015 to December 31, 2016.
- Section 2. <u>Eligible Expenses.</u> Be it further resolved that only those streets, highways and operations as listed and described on the approved Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs, including supplemental or revised estimates approved in connection with this resolution, are eligible for maintenance with Motor Fuel Tax funds during the period as specified above.
- Section 3. Reporting Requirements. Be if further resolved that the Clerk shall, as soon as practicable after the close of the period as given above, submit to the Illinois Department of Transportation, on forms furnished by said Department, a certified statement showing expenditures from and balances remaining in the account(s) for this period.
- Section 4. <u>Notice to District Office.</u> Be it further resolved that the Clerk shall immediately transmit two certified copies of this Resolution to the district office of the Department of Transportation, at Ottawa, Illinois.
- Section 5. <u>Authority to Execute.</u> The Village President and Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, including Exh. A.
- Section 6. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Resolutions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution. All resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption and approval.


