RESOLUTION NO. R-3-14-1

A RESOLUTION FOR MAINTENANCE OF STREETS AND HIGHWAYS BY THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY UNDER THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 7 ("Municipal Administration of Streets"), Division 2 ("Use of Motor Fuel Tax Funds") of the Illinois Highway Code, 605 ILCS 5/7-202 et seq., the Village of Bradley, Kankakee, County, Illinois ("Village") may use Motor Fuel Tax Funds for the purposes set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Illinois Highway Code, the Village hereby appropriates the amount of Motor Fuel Tax Funds set forth in this Resolution for the calendar year January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, as follows:

<u>Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.</u> The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

<u>Section 2. Appropriation of Motor Fuel Tax Funds</u>, The Village hereby appropriates the sum of \$430,000.00 of Motor Fuel Tax Funds for the purpose of maintaining streets and highways under the applicable provisions of the Illinois Highway Code from January 1, 2014 to December 1, 2014.

Section 3. Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs. Only those streets, highways, and operations as listed and described on the Village's Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs, including supplemental or revised estimates approved in connection with this Resolution, are eligible for maintenance with Motor Fuel Tax fluids during the period set forth in Section 2 above.

Section 4. Certified Statement by Village Clerk. The Village Clerk, or his designee shall, as soon as practicable after the close of the period set forth in Section 2 above, submit to the Illinois Department of Transportation ("Department"), on forms furnished by said Department, a certified statement showing expenditures from and balances remaining in the accounts for the period set forth in Section 2 above.

Section 5. Certification of Resolution. The Village Clerk shall immediately transmit two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the district office of the Department, Ottowa, Illinois.

Section 6. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Resolutions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect

any of the other provisions of this Resolution. All resolutions, ordinances and motions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take eddect from and after its adoption and approval.
