A RESOLUTION WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND OUTFITTING OF NINE CHEVROLET TAHOE SUVS FOR USE BY THE BRADLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-1-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-1-1), the Corporate Authorities of the Village have authority to establish and equip its police department (the "Department"); and
- WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary and expedient to purchase and outfit nine (9) Chevrolet Tahoe SUVs (the "Vehicles") for use by the Department; and
- WHEREAS, Chief of Police (the "Chief") of the Village of Bradley has identified that Miles Chevrolet in Decatur, Illinois, presently has sufficient Vehicles in stock to satisfy the Village's needs; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief has determined that the Vehicles are not reasonably available from other sources, in part due to shortages and supply line disruptions on account of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, the Chief has further determined that Williams Communications, Advance Computers, and the Illinois fire and Police Store in Bourbonnais, Illinois, are each ready and willing to outfit the Vehicles to meet the Department's needs; and
- WHEREAS, in light of these facts, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined, by a two-thirds (2/3) supermajority vote of the trustees presently holding office, that it is necessary and expedient to waive any and all competitive bidding procedures that might otherwise be applicable to the purchase and outfitting of the Vehicles; and
- WHEREAS, the aggregate state price for the Vehicles is three hundred forty-five thousand, two hundred forty and 00/100 dollars (\$345,240.00); and
- WHEREAS, the total cost of outfitting the Vehicles is ninety-eight thousand, three hundred seventy and 00/100 dollars (\$98,370.00); and
- WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to approve the purchase and outfitting of the Vehicles from the vendors and at the prices stated above, and further to waive competitive bidding in relation to said purchases.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Acting Village President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct Police Chief Donald Barber (the "Chief") to purchase nine (9) Chevrolet Tahoe SUVs (the "Vehicles") from Miles Chevrolet in Decatur, provided that the total aggregate price for the Vehicles shall not exceed three hundred forty-five thousand, two hundred forty and 00/100 dollars (\$345,240.00). The Chief further authorized and directed to take any action and sign any document necessary to accomplish the purchase of the Vehicles authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby authorize and direct the Chief to take any action and/or enter into any agreement(s) necessary to adequately outfit the Vehicles for the Department's use with any and/or all of: Williams Communications, Advanced Computers, and/or the Illinois Fire and Police Store, provided that the total cost of such outfitting shall not exceed ninety-eight thousand, three hundred seventy and 00/100 dollars (\$98,370.00).

SECTION 4. The Corporate Authorities hereby waive, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the trustees presently holding office, any and all competitive bidding requirements as might otherwise be applicable to the purchases authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 5. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 7. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
